- Operate all types of mowing equipment maintaining greens, aprons, tees, collars, fairways, rough, around trees, fence lines, banks and hillsides, edges cart paths; rakes, edges and maintains sand bunkers.
- Maintains fuel and fluid levels for all types of equipment on a daily basis, reports equipment problems or failure to the equipment manager immediately.
- Golf course set up on tees and greens according to daily rotation; removes debris and weeds; and repairs divots and ball marks.
- Weed control and management.
- Water and fertilize tees, greens, fairways, and roughs.
- Irrigation maintenance.
- Golf course construction and landscaping projects.
- Ensure quality and attention to detail exists in all work performed (accurate, thorough, and timely).
- Demonstrate a positive, friendly, and outgoing attitude always.
- Always demonstrate professionalism.
- Exhibit a willingness to learn new tasks and perform manual labor.
