



AGSA - Jack Fairhurst *Superintendent of the Year Award*

The AGSA Superintendent of the Year award is presented to a member Superintendent who exemplifies the profession of Golf Course Superintendent.

This award is meant to reflect the recipient's dedication to the greenskeeping profession through continuing education, maintenance practices and management skills. The budget of a golf course shall in no way reflect the suitability of the candidate for the award.

The intent of this award is to be peer driven by AGSA members and as such, nominations must come from Class A or B member superintendents. The nominations can be forwarded to the AGSA office by January 15, 2026. The board of Directors will appoint a selection committee to determine the recipient of the award. The award presentation will be made during the Atlantic Turfgrass Conference.

The award will only be given in years when there are nominations received and the nominees meet the following criteria.

1. Be actively employed as a Golf Course Superintendent in Atlantic Canada.
2. Be an AGSA member in good standing.
3. Apply sound principles in a turfgrass agronomy program.
4. Apply sound business and management skills.
5. Apply sound environmental and IPM skills.
6. Actively attempt to expand their professional knowledge and skills through education and seminars.

The recipient of the AGSA Superintendent of the Year Award will receive a free registration package to the Atlantic Turfgrass Conference along with a plaque recognizing the award.
